## Prayer Letter 4TH QUARTER 2022

Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

We would like to say thank you to the ones of you that have sent us your prayer letters as well. We enjoy seeing how God has been working there in the States in each one of your churches. We are praying for you all, and we are honored to be an extension of your ministries by serving here in the Dominican Republic.

Exciting things have been happening here. We have seen the fingerprints of God throughout all of it. As you all know, for the past two years we have working under Pastor/Missionary Steve Sidler. What a blessing it has been to be a part of the ministry of Mount Calvary Baptist Church in Quita Sueno. During the past two years we have been fervently praying for God to show us where to plant a church here in the Dominican Republic. Honestly, everywhere we have visited in the past two years we have seen many cities without churches. My wife and I have been praying about where God would lead us to plant a church, but He never gave us peace about a certain city. We can finally say that God has given my wife and me a peace that passes all understanding to plant a church in the city of El Limon, in the peninsula of the Province of Samana. Many times God is working in the background, organizing and arranging things until the timing is Perfect to reveal His Will to us.

Five years ago, I was invited to take a survey trip to the Peninsula of Samana with some visiting pastors and Pastor Sidler. One of the pastors had the vision to bring a group to evangelize the entire peninsula in 10 days. Throughout the past year that pastor has come down to scout the area and to book the hotel. Then in August, I went back up to secure the hotel for the group that was coming. Ever since January we have been praying about Province of Samana fervently. Each time I went up there the more I began to notice how many people lived on the Peninsula, yet there aren't any Bible believing churches of any kind.

Three weeks before the trip, the pastor in Las Terrenas, Samana, (currently the First Baptist Church of Samana) called and asked Carlos if we could come in December and take care of the church while he and his family will be in the States for the holidays. Many times God is working behind the scenes and paying the way for us and many times it is not till later that we realize it was His hand working all along. On November 7 the group arrived from the States. On November 12, my wife and I were driving a group to the city of El Limon to begin soul winning. Just in that day we had two people tell us that they have been waiting for a church to come, and then one lady pointed at me and said her family would be our first members. The people of El Limon have been praying for a church to come and we are excited to see how God is answering their prayers and ours.

In the last 10 days 40,000 Romans were passed out, and over 3,000 people received Christ! We're excited to see what doors God opens up as we prepare to plant a church in El Limon.

Prayer requests for a few things that need to happen for us to move there:

1. Finances for a house and moving cost  
- For the past two weeks we have been in the area looking for a house to rent. We have asked around and spoken to different people about a house to rent, but there just aren't many houses in the area. Praise the Lord we did find a house. The house has been sitting empty, and no one has ever lived in it. The house is missing quite a few things: flooring, kitchen, bathroom, electricity, and plumbing. We have spoken with the owner, and he is open to us renting at a discounted price in the hopes of us buying it in 2-3 years. Therefore we would be responsible for finishing the house and making it livable. We have spoken with a lawyer and the owner of the house and they are in agreement with a set rent amount and 50% of that would be required to go to renovations.
2. Finances to buy land/and build a church (We did find a piece of land that is for sale for \$30,000 and the cost to build a church will be \$6,500.)
